- AlCan ONE is the **first and only all-terrestrial fiber route** connecting Alaska with the contiguous United States and beyond.
- The route has an installed capacity of over 100 terabits, which can be expanded and increased as demand grows.

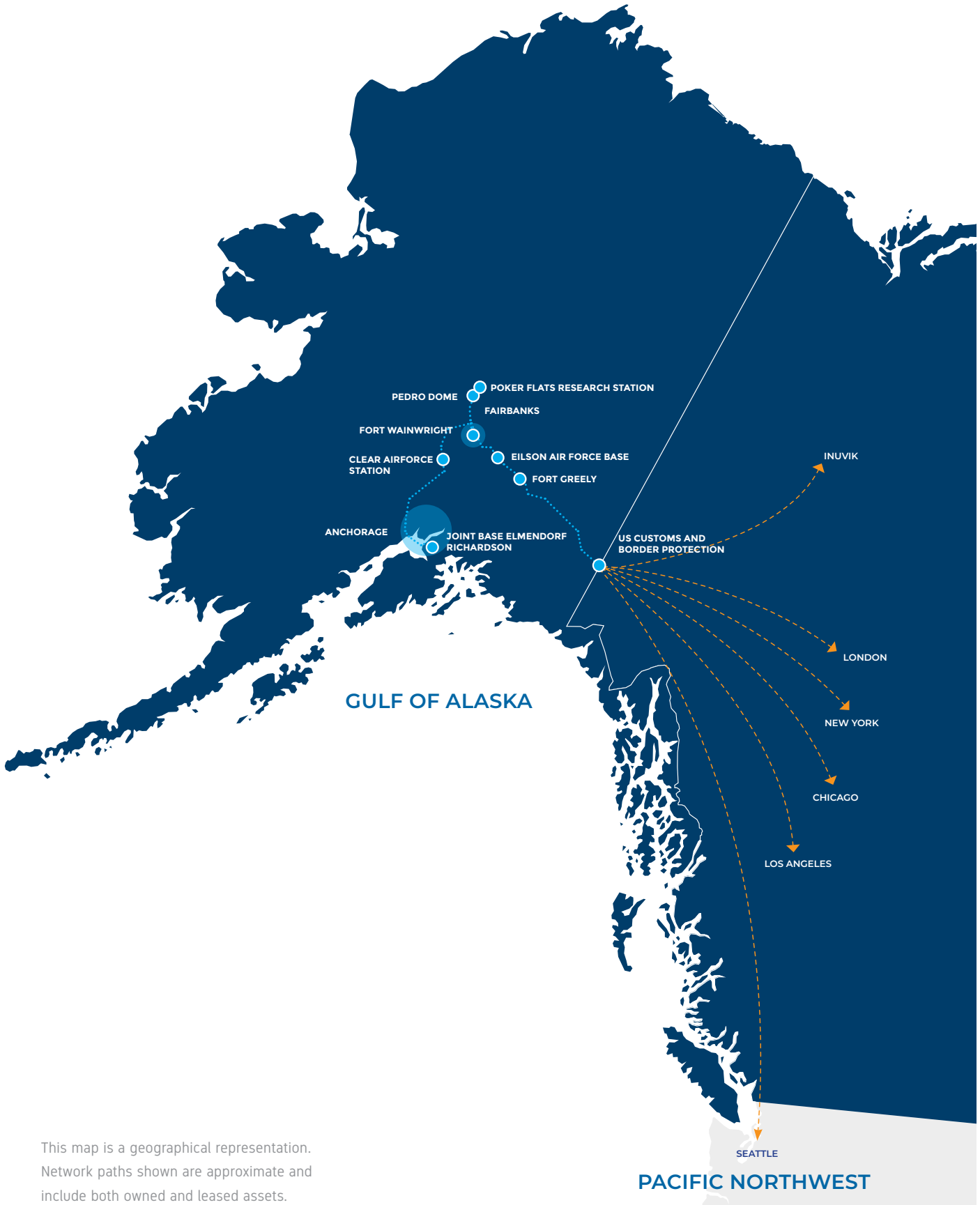
The need for new fiber

- MTA identified the need for a **long-term all-terrestrial fiber solution** to connect Alaska to the contiguous United States and beyond through a scalable and reliable connection.
- This route reduces Alaska's reliance on vulnerable undersea fiber optic cables currently in place.

A win for Alaska

- The route is **secure, reliable and easy to repair and grow.**
- Upgraded internet capacity for residents, businesses and government facilities in Alaska.
- New, scalable connectivity as demand for broadband increases throughout the region.
